

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1440

WHEREAS, It is now affirmative that various Indian Tribes in the State of Arizona will now benefit employment in Agriculture, and

WHEREAS, It has been brought to the attention of the San Carlos Apaches and the Papago Tribe when will benefit from this employment, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council and the San Carlos Apaches has therefore laid certain criteria which should be followed in the employment of these members, and

WHEREAS, That the members of these tribes be given the best suitable employment, living conditions, wages, food service, and transportation, and

WHEREAS, The State Employment Service and the U.S. Department of Farm Labor be the only sole recruiters of these tribes, and

WHEREAS, The employers will have to meet the standards of the Federal and the State criteria of working conditions and let it be known that wildest recruiting will not be permitted on these reservations.

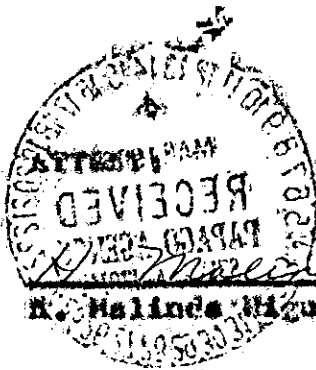
NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that foregoing criteria be followed and this be brought to the attention of the office of State Employment Service, Bureau of Employment Security, U.S. Department of Labor, and Bureau of Indian Affairs,

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the employers pay the National minimum wage schedule and the employees benefit from workmans compensation and unemployment compensation.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on March 4, 1966, with a vote of 18 for, 0 against, and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (F) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
