

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 144

WHEREAS, on December 6, 1965, the Sells District Council passed a resolution approving the request of the Nazarene Church to build a church at Sells, Sells District, Papago Reservation, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, the Sells District Council has approved the land in the Sells Community, the site to be approximately one and one half (1½) acres, for an indefinite period, the site to be used for religious purposes only, and

WHEREAS, the land herein described will revert back to the use of the Papago Tribe when it is no longer used for religious purposes by the Nazarene Church,

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council, that the Nazarene Church is hereby given permission to construct a church on approximately 1½ acres of land for an indefinite period.

The foregoing Resolution was on March 4, 1966, duly enacted by a vote of 19 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V, and Section 7 of Article VIII of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (Stat. 984).
