

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL



RES. NO. 444

WHEREAS, Papago Tribal Judge Lloyd Ignacio resigned as Tribal Judge effective on January 3, 1966, and

WHEREAS; On January 7, 1966, Mabel P. Antone of Sells was recommended to the Council by the Superintendent of the Papago Indian Agency, under authority vested in him by Chapter 1, Section 2, of the Papago Law and Order Code, said appointment to be subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the Papago Council, and

WHEREAS, The said Chapter 1, Section 2, of the Code provides that each Judge shall hold office for a period of two (2) years unless sooner removed, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council on January 7, 1966 accepted and approved the resignation of Lloyd Ignacio from his position of Chief Tribal Judge of the Papago Tribal Court, effective January 3, 1966;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, That the Papago Council hereby confirms, accepts, and approves the appointment of Mabel P. Antone as Chief Tribal Judge of the Papago Tribal Court, said appointment to run until March 4, 1968, unless sooner removed, in accordance with the provisions of the Papago Tribal Law and Order Code.

The above resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on March 4, 1966, with a vote of 19 for 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
