

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1448

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council requested that Congressman Morris K. Udall introduce a bill in the United States Congress to allow the Tribe to lease its land for a term up to 99 years, and

WHEREAS, Congressman Udall has introduced House Bill No. 7648 and there have been hearings before the House Subcommittee on Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council desires that the Congressional Committee be advised that the Papago people are in full support of House Bill No. 7648,

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council endorses House Bill No. 7648 in toto to provide long term leasing for the Sells, Gila Bend and San Xavier Reservations, and requests that the House Subcommittee on Indian Affairs urge the passage of the Bill during this session of Congress to permit the full development of the three Reservations that comprise the estate of the Papago Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on April 1, 1966, with a vote of 17 for, 0 against, and 0 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (c) and (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
