RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. 1452

WHEREAS, The National Congress of American Indians called a special emergency meeting of all Indian Tribes to be held in Santa Fe, New Mexico from April 12 to April 15, 1966, and

WHEREAS, The subject of the meeting will be the transfer of all present Poverty Funds and programs to the Bureau of Indian Affairs to be administered by them, and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council feels this meeting is important enough to send the Tribal Chairman as delegate on behalf of the Papago Tribe.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, By the Papago Tribal Council that it authorize the Chairman to attend the meeting in Santa Fe, New Mexico on April 12-15, 1966, and that it appropriate enough money to cover his expenses, including transportation.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on April 1, 1966 with a vote of 17 for, 0 against and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and by Laws of the Papago Tribe.
