PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
RESOLUTION

Resolution # 1456

WHEREAS, GILA RIVER RANCH, INC. an Arizona corporation, as grantor; heretofore by Quit Claim Deed dated March 27, 1961, recorded on May 11, 1961, in the Office of the County Recorder of Maricopa County, Arizona, conveyed to the Papago Tribe of Arizona and the Gila Bend District of the Papago Tribe, as grantees, the certain real property situated in the County of Maricopa, State of Arizona, described as follows:

A tract of land located in Section 23, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, Gila and Salt River Base & Meridian; more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the N.E. corner of said Section 23; thence S. $0^{\circ} 09'23''$ E. along the east line of said Section 23 twelve hundred ninety-eight and eighty-nine hundredths feet (1298.89') to a point; thence S. $32^{\circ}30'51''$ W. sixteen hundred thirty-four and four hundredths feet (1634.04') to a point; thence N. $19^{\circ}03'57''$ W. seven hundred sixty-two and forty-eight hundredths feet (768.48') to a point; thence N. $0^{\circ}04'47''$ W. seven hundred sixty-six and ninety-six hundredths feet (766.96') to a point on the north line of said Section 23; thence N. $09^{\circ}15'30''$ E. along the north line of said Section 23 eighteen hundred sixteen and eighty-six hundredths feet (1866.86') to the point of beginning;



WHEREAS, said Quit Claim Deed erroneously described the real property intended to be conveyed by the grantor and accepted by the grantees,

NOW, THEREFORE, for the sole purpose of correcting said error and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10), Gila River Ranch, Inc., Grantor herein, does hereby quit-claim to the Papago Tribe, Grantee herein, all that certain real property situated in the County of Maricopa, State of Arizona, described as follows; to wit:

That portion of Section Twenty-three (23), Township Five (5) South, Range Five (5) West of the Gila & Salt River Base & Meridian; described as follows:

Strip of land, 20 feet in width, being that portion of the Northeast Quarter of Section 23, Township 5 South, Range 5 West of the Gila & Salt River Base & Meridian, said strip of land lying 10.00 feet on each side



of the following described center line;

COMMENCING at the Northeast corner of said Section 23; thence South 73 degrees 07 minutes 08 seconds West 1229.59 feet; thence West 37.99 feet to the true point of beginning of said strip of land; thence North 68 degrees 54 minutes East 7.37 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve concave Northwesterly, having a radius of 87.54 feet; thence Northeasterly 104.67 feet along said curve through a central angle of 68 degrees 30 minutes 36 seconds; thence North 0 degrees 23 minutes 24 seconds East 275.23 feet, more or less, to the point of ending in the North line of said Section 23, said point of ending being distant Westerly approximately 1150 feet from the Northeast corner of said Section; and that portion of the Northeast Quarter of Section 23, Township 5 South, Range 5 West of the Gila & Salt River Base & Meridian, bearings based upon a bearing of South 0 degrees 05 minutes 41 seconds West for the East line of said Northeast Quarter described as follows:


BEGINNING at a point distant South 73 degrees 07 minutes 08 seconds West 1229.59 feet from the Northeast corner of said Section 23; thence South 610 feet; thence West 515 feet; thence North 610 feet; thence East 515 feet to the point of beginning.


This conveyance is for the purpose of correcting the said Quit Claim Deed dated March 27, 1961.


The above Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on May 6, 1966, with a vote of 20 for, 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 934), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.


