PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL RESOLUTION

RES. # 1457

WHEREAS, The residents of Sil Murk Village will be moving to a new site to be acquired by the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, There are other Papago (Indiana living in an area known as Gila Bend Indian Village immediately south of the town of Gila Bend, and said Indian village being located on private land belonging to non-Indians, and these Papagos could be evicted from the premises at any time at the will of the land-owners, and

WHEREAS . It is the desire of the district council to bring together in one community the Papagos living in the area in order that they might enjoy better facilities, communal life and govern-

BB IT THERBFORE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribe that the Eiseinei section-25, T. 5 S., R. 5 W., GUSRM Arizona, containing 20 acres, be purchased for the purpose that the amount of \$15,000.00 be withdrawn from funds on deposit with the Treasurer of the United States for the account of Gila Bend District Council; and that said land be acquired by the United States of America in trust for the Papago Tribe of Arizona pursuant to Act of June 18, 1934 or Act of August 20, 1964 (78 Stat. 559).

The above Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on May 6, 1966, with a vote of 20 for, 0 against and 0 not voting during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the council by Section 3 (a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 934), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
