## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

## Res. No. 1462

WHEREAS, at a meeting held May 27, 1966, at which a quorum was present; the Baboquivori District Council approved a Budget for the 1967 Fiscal Year, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the approved budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the district.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the Papago Tribal Council that the Baboquivori District Budget for the 1967 Fiscal Year be approved as follows:

At the end of the 1966 Fiscal Year the Baboquivori District had a balance of \$520.00 in its District Treasury:

- 1. Gasoline for water Pump \$500.00 engines
- 2. Engine repairs 400.00
  - 3. Payment of Electric Bill for Topwa Village (\$10 per month) 120.00
  - 4. District Fence Maintenance including supplies and hired help 441.60 Total \$1,461.00

While the proposed expenditures are larger than the cash balance now on hand, the District during the current Fiscal Year will receive grazing fees in the approximate amount of \$1,000. In addition, if, during the course of the Fiscal Year, income does not come up to expected standards, the district will make a comparative reduction in expenditures.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the District Chairman or the Vice-Chairman of the Baboquivori District Council be permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on June 3, 1966 with a vote of 17 for, 0 against, and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
