The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on June 3, 1966 with a vote of 19 for, 0 against, and 0 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
