RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHERBAS, the Papago Tribal Council received from the Department of the Army, Los Angeles District; Corps of Engineers, P.O. Box 2711; Los Angeles, California to release lease No. DA-04-353-BNG-9522, Covered Wells Gap Filler Annex, Sells, Arizona, (TM-181B), and lease No. DA-04-353-BNG-9494, Sells Gap Filler Annex, Pima County, Arizona, and

Whereas, one percel of land containing a total of 0.51 acre, more or less and commonly known as Covered Wells Gap Filler Annex TN-181B, together with the right of ingress and egress thereto, and one parcel of land containing a total of 0.51 acre, more or less, and commonly known as Sells Gap Filler Annex M-92A, together with the right of ingress and ogress thereto, and

WHEREAS, the use of said premises is no longer required by the Corps of Engineers and possession of said property having been redelivered by the United States of America to the lessor, on the 4th day of June 1966, and

WHERBAS, the Papago Tribal Council; authorizes its Chairman to sign the copies of the rolosse for execution:

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY TRIBAL COUNCIL that the Chairman be authorised to sign the release for execution. T

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on June 3, 1966 with a vote of 17 for 0 sgainst, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the council by Section 2 of Article V and Article VIII of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6 of the Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
