

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL.

Rec. No. 1468

WHEREAS, the Tribal Herd 1/2 ton Chevrolet Truck, which is now used by the Tribal Herd Manager was purchased new in June 1963, and

WHEREAS, said truck has now been driven in excess of 71,300 miles and has been appraised for turn-in value on the purchase of a new truck by O'Rielly Chevrolet Company of Tucson, and,

WHEREAS, the sum of \$750.00 will be allowed by the O'Rielly Company as a credit for the old truck upon purchase of a new 1966 model Chevrolet 1/2 ton truck, the new truck costing \$2,373.10, including accessory equipment, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes it would be beneficial to the Tribe to purchase a new truck at this time for the reason that the old truck is deteriorating quickly and is costing various sums for repairs and replacement and the council believes that the expenditures will continue as long as the Tribe retains possession of the old truck.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby orders and directs that the Tribe immediately purchase a new 1966 model Chevrolet 1/2 ton truck from O'Rielly Chevrolet Company of Tucson at a purchase price of \$2,373.10 including necessary equipment, thereby taking advantage of the credit of \$750.00 turn-in credit on the old 1963 pick-up truck now owned by the Tribe.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that funds for the purchase of the said new truck shall be taken from the Tribal Herd 1967 Budget, in which there is a provision in the Budget of \$1,700.00 to purchase a new pick-up truck.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on June 3, 1966, with a vote of 18 for, 0 against, and 0 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 12, 1937, (Stat. - 954), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
