RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1472

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs erected a building in Santa Rosa Village on the Papago Reservation in Arizona for the purpose of a Community Center, and

WHEREAS, the building has been completed in September 20, 1965 and is now ready for occupancy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the building (with equipment listed below) be accepted as one of its buildings from the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

- Building No. 450 - Santa Rosa Community Center
- H54-1115 Refrigerator, H54-1395 Range and
- H54-1408 Refrigerator

Provided, that the Papago Tribal Council be responsible for maintenance, repairs, upkeep, and receive all rental payments from the building.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 1, 1966 with a vote of 18 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
