

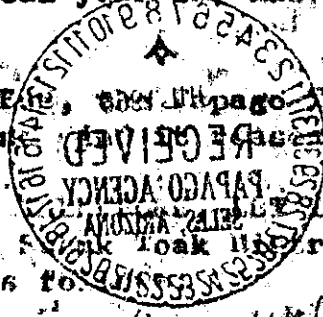
RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1473

WHEREAS, at a meeting held May 29, 1966, at which a quorum was present, the Schuk Toak District Council approved a budget for the 1966 fiscal year and had submitted it to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed budget and has found it reasonable and to the benefit of the district.

NOW, LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the Papago Tribal Council that the Schuk Toak District Budget for the 1967 fiscal year be approved as follows:



Sil. Nakia	\$300.00
Fresnal Ranch	300.00
Havan Nakya	300.00
Pan Tak	300.00
Viopuli	300.00
Santa Rosa Ranch	300.00
Kon Vaya	300.00
Cardia Ranch Strip	300.00
Truck Maintenance and Operation	300.00
Total	\$3000.00

The District has decided to continue dividing the money for the budget so it will be spend equally among the villages in the District, and when it does not work out satisfactorily, a new way of setting up the budget will be considered.

It is understood that the money spent will be used for the needs of the villages named, and any amount not used will be considered as remaining a part of the district account.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, the Treasurer of the Schuk Toak District Council or his authorized representative be permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 1, 1966 with a vote of 16 for 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By laws of the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior of January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section.
