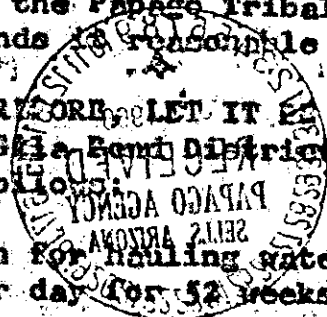
RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1474

WHEREAS, at a meeting held June 29, 1966, at which a quorum was present, the Gila Bend District Council approved a Budget for the 1966 Fiscal Year and has submitted it to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the Papago Tribal Council that the Gila Bend District Budget for the 1967 Fiscal Year be approved as follows:



Provision for hauling water 5 days per week at \$8.00 per day for 52 weeks	\$2,080.00
Car Repairs when necessary	300.00
General and Regular needs and purposes of the District	<u>1,000.00</u>
Total	\$3,380.00

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Gila Bend District Council or his authorized representative be permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 1, 1966, with a vote of 17 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
