

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Res. NO. 1476

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council is interested in maintaining adequate financial records in connection with the financial operation of the Papago Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Council is desirous of having adequate books and records maintained in the Tribal office, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have a professional accountant supervise the accounting records of the Council, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Shelby Atkinson has agreed to enter into a contract with the Papago Tribal Council for the sum of \$1,200.00 per year, payable at the rate of \$100.00 per month.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Papago Council hereby orders and directs the Tribal officials to enter into and execute on behalf of the Papago Tribe, a written agreement with Shelby Atkinson, accountant. Said written agreement is hereto annexed.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 1, 1966, with a vote of 19 for, 0 against and 0 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (b) and Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
