

RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1482

WHEREAS, At a regular meeting at which a quorum was present, the Hickiwan District Council approved a budget for the 1967 Fiscal Year and has submitted it to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the district has a balance of \$41.32 in its District II-M Account, and

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council, that the Hickiwan District Budget for the 1967 Fiscal Year be approved as follows:

The amount of \$41.32 to be kept in reserve to be used only for emergency purposes in the district.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Hickiwan District or his authorized representative be permitted to sign the purchase orders for the above purposes in the amount specified.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on August 5, 1966 with a vote of 17 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984); pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
