RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO.1483

WHERBAS, The Associate Judge, Joe Rieno, of the Papago Tribal Court was disqualified on July 7, 1966 in the appeal case of The Papago Tribe Vs Heary Jose, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Court recognized the defendant's right to such an appeal, and

WHEREAS, Oliver K. Moristo, a member of the Papago Tribe was recommended to the Papago Tribal Council for appointment as temporary Associate Judge in the Papago Tribe Vm Henry Jose appeal case.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that Oliver K. Moristo be appointed as Associate Judge in the Papago Tribe Vs Henry Jose appeal case.

HE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT perdiem at the rate of ten dollars a day (\$10) shall be allowed the Associate Judge for his services in the Tribal Court.

The foregoing resolutions was on August 5, 1966, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for, and 0 against and 4 not voting by the Papage Tribal Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (b) Article V of the constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1935, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6. 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (Stat. 984) Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitutution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
