RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1484

WHEREAS, Limbaugh-Engineers, Inc., from Albuquerque, New Mexico, a firm under contract to the National Radio Astronomy Observatory making a study of various sites for a Radiotelescope facility has made a request of a Right-of-Entry for Survey to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, one of the sites under consideration for such a site is within the boundaries of the Papago Indian Reservation located in the Schuk Toak District, and

WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council has agreed to grant the Right-of-Entry to Limbaugh Engineers, Inc. to make their survey for the Radiotelescope site facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the Right-of-Entry be granted to the Limbaugh Engineers, Inc. for the project stated above.

The foregoing resolution was on August 5, 1966, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. (Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
