

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES: 1486

WHEREAS, The Arizona Highway Department, has made application for a drainage easement to be located along the north boundary line of San Xavier Allotment No. 68, now escheated to the Papago Tribe, and

WHEREAS, The drainage easement will be on each side of Tucson-Nogales Interstate Highway and is needed for the protection of adjacent Indian lands from floods, and

WHEREAS, Only .02 acre of land will be taken for the easement and on which Arizona Highway Department has offered to pay \$25.00 and

WHEREAS, The San Xavier District Council at a meeting held September 1, 1966, approved by resolution to grant the drainage easement to the Arizona Highway Department, in the area indicated above and that the payment of \$25.00 be accepted and same dividend equally between the Papago Tribe and San Xavier District Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the drainage easement be granted to the Arizona Highway Department in accordance as indicated above,

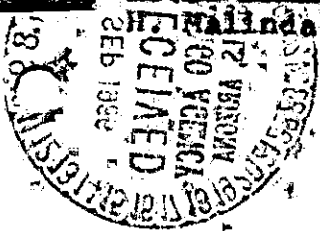
The above resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on September 2, 1966, with a vote of 17 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the council by Section 2 (a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
