

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 147

WHEREAS, The Sif Oidak District Council has approved a budget for the 1967 Fiscal Year and has submitted it to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the Papago Tribal Council that the Sif Oidak District Budget for the 1967 Fiscal Year be approved as follows:

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Sif Oidak District Council or his duly authorized representative be permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on September 2, 1966 with a vote of 18 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2(f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act. of June 18, 1934.
