

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1488

WHEREAS, Juan Jose, Councilman from Chukut Kuk District, inclines to exceed his authority in the Tribal Council meetings, and the attitude that he takes on matters which come before the council for action, and

WHEREAS, There have been numerous criticisms among the council members about Juan Jose and his conduct toward the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Chukut Kuk District election is now under protest and filed in the Papago Tribal Court waiting for a hearing and judgement of the election procedure in that district, the Council now feels that Juan Jose is part of the protest as a representative of his district, and

WHEREAS, The Council agreed to remove Juan Jose from the Council membership for the reason that he is unfit to hold office as Councilman.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that Juan Jose be removed from the Papago Tribal Council for the reasons indicated above.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1966 duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 3 of Article III, and Section 2(f) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 9840). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.

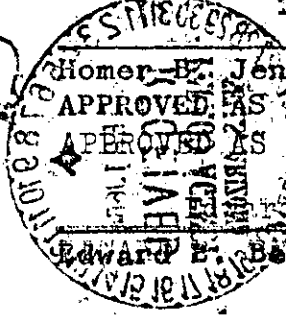
