RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1492

WHEREAS, There is 1966 Annual conference of Judges to be held at the Broadmoor Hotel, Colorado Springs, October 31 to November 4, 1966, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council feel that this conference is important enough to send Mrs. Mable Antene the Judge to this conference to gain further knowledge of judicial work and techniques of Law and Order.

NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it authorize the Judge to attend the Judge's Conference in Colorado Springs from October 31, to November 4, 1966, and that it appropriate enough money to cover expenses including transportation.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on October 21, 1966 with a vot of 17 for and 0 against and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in by the Council by Section 3 (A) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By Laws of the Papago Tribe.
