WHEREAS, The Sif Oidak District, Council Papago Indian Reservation, and the Surgeon General of the United States Public Health Service discussed and agreed that Sif Oidak District set aside approximately \$2,250.00 towards drilling a New Domestic Well for the Village of Cockleburr located in the Sif Oidak District, Papago Reservation, and E

WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council understands that the estimated cost of the Well will be \$4,500.00, at which the United States Public Health Service agrees to pay half of the cost, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council understands the need of a new Well for Cockleburr Village Sif Gidak District, Papago Reservation:

NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Papago Council hereby recommend to the United States Public Service, Indian Health that they pay half of the cost of drilling a new Domestic Well for the village of Cockleburr and the Sif Cidak District to pay the other half of the cost.

The Toregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on October 21, 1966, with a vote of 17 for, 0 against, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (A) and Section 2(P) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe
