RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1495

WHEREAS, THE Tribal Livestock Inspector's $\frac{1}{2}$ ton Chevrolet Truck, which is now used by Thomas Throssell was purchased new in 1962, and

WHEREAS, Said Truck has now been driven in excess of 73,594 miles and has been appraised for turn-in value on the purchase of a new truck by Murray Bryant Chevrolet Company of Tucson, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, The sum of \$714.30 will be allowed by the Murray Bryant Company of Tucson as credit for the old truck upon purchase of a new 1967 model Chevrolet $\frac{1}{2}$ ton truck, the new truck costing \$2,374.30, including necessary equipment, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council believes it would be beneficial to the Tribe to purchase a new truck at this time for the reason that the old truck is deteriorating quickly and is costing various sums for repairs and replacement and the council believes that expenditures will continue as long as the Tribe retains possession of the old truck.


NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby orders and directs that the Tribe immediately purchase a New 1967 model Chevrolet $\frac{1}{2}$ ton truck including necessary equipment, thereby taking advantage of the credit of \$714.30 turn-in credit value on the old 1962 pick-up truck now owned by the Tribe.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that funds for the purchase of the said new Truck shall be taken from the Livestock Department Account.

THE FOREGOING RESOLUTION was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on October 21, 1966 with a vote of 17 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 12, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
