

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1497

WHEREAS, on July 28, 1966 to November 22, 1966, there was court hearings held at the Papago Tribal Court concerning the problems on January 15, 1966 elections in the Chukut Kuk District, and

WHEREAS, the court came upon these factors that the defendants namely Archie Hendricks, Henry Jose and Juan Jose were members of the District Council at the time of the election and that they were also active members of the Election Committee of the Chukut Kuk District, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council also named Ramon Chavez as past District Chairman and also Tribal Herd Manager, and

WHEREAS, that the said Ordinance 27 is for the use of every district to follow where elections are concerned.

WHEREAS, the people named above have caused this Tribal Council election problems every year, and

WHEREAS, there have been many protests made by other members of this district,

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT the Papago Tribal Council appoint eight (8) people to assist in conducting the voting in the Chukut Kuk District for the year 1967. The four men named Archie Hendricks, Henry Jose, Juan Jose and Ramon Chavez may not take part in the District Council and the Papago Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on December 2, 1966 with a vote of 19 for and 0 against, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) and Section 3 (b) of the Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
