

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1493

WHEREAS, at the Baboquivori District Meeting of November 12, 1966, it was recommended that forty (40) acres of land, in the selected area within Baboquivori District be placed under leased conditions to Mr. Edward N. Kisto for his home, occupancy and beneficial use, and

WHEREAS, the District, considering that he is a member of the Papago Tribe and registered in the district, determined that the lease be for an indefinite time or until he informs the District authorities that he has no use for the land, and

WHEREAS, the District has recommended that a lease be granted to Edward N. Kisto in accordance with the Act of August 9, 1955 and the regulations issued thereunder.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the lease be made to Mr. Edward N. Kisto under the terms stated above.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on December 2, 1966, with a vote of 19 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
