

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1968

WHEREAS; In accordance with the provisions of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe of Arizona, and the provisions of Ordinance Nos. 18 and 27 of The Papago Council, The Papago Council and on February 2, 1968 duly elect a Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, and a Treasurer; and

WHEREAS; It is the decision of The Papago Council that a special day be set aside as Inauguration Day and appropriate ceremonies held to signalize the inauguration of the new officials of the Papago Tribe on the occasion of their entrance into their new offices;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL; That February 17, 1968 be set aside as Inauguration Day for The Papago Tribe, on which day the newly elected Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, and Treasurer of The Papago Council shall take their oath of office; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; That Josiah N. Moore, Vincent Manuel, Agnes R. Cragg, Clifford Morisco, and Elena Frank are hereby appointed to serve on the Papago Inauguration Committee; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED; That the above named committee shall assume full responsibility for all of the arrangements necessary for a successful Inauguration Day;

PROVIDED; That all expenses which may be incurred in the preparations and carrying out the Inauguration ceremonies shall be paid for from the available Tribal funds; and

PROVIDED FURTHER; That Per Diem and Mileage expenses of the Papago Inauguration Committee shall be paid for from available Tribal funds, in accordance with the established rates.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 2, 1968 duly enacted by The Papago Council by a vote of 17 For and 0 against, pursuant to authority vested in it by section 2 (c), (f); and Section 3 (d) of Article V of the Constitution of The Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 3, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
