

RESOLUTION OF PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Transferring building to Sif Oidak District)

RES. NO. 2-76

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe did receive certain buildings and improve-
2 ments located in Chuichu, Sif Oidak District, from the
3 Bureau of Indian Affairs for the use and benefit of the
4 Sif Oidak District; and

5 WHEREAS, said buildings and improvements are properly the property
6 of the Sif Oidak District.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the
8 following described buildings and improvements located in
9 Chuichu, Sif Oidak District, together with any attachments
10 therein or thereon, are hereby transferred, assigned, and
11 set over to the Sif Oidak District, to-wit:

- 12 1. Building 601 - quonset hut.
- 13 2. Building 602 - two (2) bedroom quarters.
- 14 3. Building 603 - two (2) stall garage.
- 15 4. Building 604 - two (2) bedroom quarters.
- 16 5. Building 605 - pump house.
- 17 6. Gas system with 1000 gallon propane tank and six (6)
18 underground piping systems.
- 19 7. Water system with 11500 gallon water storage tank and
20 well equipped with submersible pump and underground
21 distribution system.
- 22 8. Sewage system with three (3) sewage lagoons and an
23 underground distribution system.

24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
25 the 15th day of January, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was
26 present with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting;
27 and 3 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council
28 by Section 2 (a) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-
29 laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on
30 December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
31 on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the
32 Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date

1 of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is
2 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
