

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 3-76

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Constitution provides that each District shall  
2 through its District Council, govern itself and manage  
3 its local affairs, including the preparation and adoption  
4 of District budgets; and  
5 WHEREAS, the Papago Constitution impresses upon the Papago Council  
6 the obligation of controlling all Tribal funds not under  
7 the control of Congress, and of recommending appropriation  
8 of Tribal and other funds within the control of Congress  
9 or of the Secretary of Interior; and  
10 WHEREAS, the Sells District Council has prepared and adopted a Dis-  
11 trict budget for the forthcoming fiscal year; and  
12 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed said budget and finds it  
13 in every respect just and proper.  
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the bud-  
15 get of the Sells District, as prepared and adopted by its  
16 District Council and as attached hereto, is hereby approved  
17 ratified and confirmed.  
18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on  
19 the 15th day of January, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was  
20 present with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting;  
21 and 3 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council  
22 by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of  
23 the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
24 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48  
25 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.  
26 Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the  
27 Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to review by  
28 the Secretary of the Interior.
