

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Closing Pima Mines Road)


Res. No. 4-76

1 WHEREAS, American Smelting and Refining Company (ASARCO) operates
2 an open pit south of the present alignment of Pima Mines
3 Road which parallels the southern edge of the San Xavier
4 Reservation; and
5 WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Pima Mines Road be closed or re-
6 aligned in order to permit ASARCO to develop its open pit
7 operation into the San Xavier Reservation; and
8 WHEREAS, ASARCO has requested the Pima County Board of Supervisors
9 to close said road; and
10 WHEREAS, a number of land owners have requested that said road
11 remain open, or be relocated upon the San Xavier Reserva-
12 tion; and
13 WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council did review these conflict-
14 ing requests and by unanimous vote did on November 23,
15 1975, support the request of ASARCO to the Pima County
16 Board of Supervisors to close said road where it borders
17 on ASARCO's open pit operation, and did voice its objec-
18 tions to the granting of a re-location right-of-way for
19 said road on the San Xavier Reservation; and
20 WHEREAS, The Papago Council, after a review of the facts, concurs
21 with the findings of the San Xavier District Council that:
22 (1) it will be to the benefit of the San Xavier District,
23 the Papago Reservation and the economy of Southern Arizona
24 if the Pima Mines Road is closed as requested by ASARCO:
25 (2) that there is ample alternate access to all areas
26 presently served by the Pima Mines Road; and (3) that it
27 would not be in the best interest of the San Xavier Reser-
28 vation or the Papago Tribe if a relocation right-of-way
29 for said road be granted on the San Xavier Reservation.
30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby
31 support the request of ASARCO to the Pima County Board of
32 Supervisors to close the Pima Mines Road where it borders




1 on ASARCO's open pit operation.
2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does object to the
3 grant of a relocation right-of-way for said road on the
4 San Xavier Reservation.
5 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
6 the 15th day of January, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was
7 present with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting;
8 and 3 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council
9 by Section 2 (c) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of
10 the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12,
11 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6,
12 1937 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
13 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval
14 by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is not subject to
15 review by the Secretary of the Interior.
