

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Priority List for Road Construction)

RES. NO. 7-76

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has discussed the necessity for
2 numerous roads to be constructed on the Reservation for
3 many reasons, including busing, improve drainage problems,
4 heavy traffic problems in certain areas, improving bus
5 routes, improving areas where flooding occurs, and in
6 addition thereto have discussed the necessity to improve,
7 seal and chip some existing roads, and feel that the im-
8 provements discussed are in the best interests for the
9 Papago people to improve the traffic problems that exist
10 on the various roads and/or reasons for the necessity for
11 roads to be constructed,

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized to
13 execute whatever documents are necessary to accomplish the
14 necessary roads to be constructed and/or improved accord-
15 ing to the priority list for road construction as attached
16 hereto and made a part hereof.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
18 the 16th day of January, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was
19 present with a vote of 430.0 for; 251.0 against; 153.0 not voting;
20 and 2 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by
21 Section 3 (i) Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the
22 Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936,
and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937
(48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the
Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is not subject to review
by the Secretary of the Interior.
