RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL (Trust Protection - Garcia Strip)

RES. NO. 8-76

WHEREAS, the City of Tucson (and M.V.M.) have purchased a number of privately owned farm lands located near the east end of the Garcia Strip, Schuk Toak District, for the purpose of acquiring water for the city of Tucson; and

5 WHEREAS, the city of Tucson has recently drilled a number of wells and is pres-6 ently pumping water for City purposes which is lowering the water table 7 under the Garcia Strip; and

8 WHEREAS, water pumped from certain cotton farmers' wells located in or near the
9 same area are also contributing to the continuous lowering of the Reser10 vation's water table; and


11 WHEREAS, Reservation lands located in the east end of the Garcia Strip has been and will continually be materially affected by the loss of normal vegetation, loss of pasture lands and other needed plant life; and WHEREAS, Mr. Donaldson, a non-Indian, off Reservation farmer has developed a catchment system which diverts the normal flow of rainwater to the Garcia Strip and is depriving the Reservation of its prior rights to said water; and

18 WHEREAS, the non-Indian lands adjoining the Garcia Strip has lush vegetation 19 while this portion of the Garcia Strip has become a dust bowl; and 20 WHEREAS, several years ago, Mr. Donaldson allowed a large pipe to be installed 21 through his land to allow flood waters to flow to the Garcia Strip but 22 this pipe is continuously clogged with dirt and debris which prevents 23 flood waters from reaching the Reservation; and

24 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Papago Tribe that immediate action
25 be taken to protect Papago Indian water rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Trust Protection
Department of the Bureau of Indian Affairs be notified immediately of
this interference of the Papago's water rights and demand appropriate
action be taken forthwith to correct this situation and secure the
Papago Indian's water rights permanently.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the Chairman and Tribal
 Attorney take whatever actions are necessary to accomplish the purpose
