WREERED, the Papago Tribe did, on August 11, 1951, file a Land 1 Petition, Docket No. 345, before the Indian Claims Commis-2 sion against the United States claiming damages resulting 3 from the taking of title to lands and of surface and sub-4 surface minerals owned by the Papago Tribe through aborig-5 inal use and occupancy since time immemorial; and 6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe did also file a claim against the United 7 States, Docket No. 102, before the Indian Claims Commis-8 sion seeking damages for mismanagement of trust funds; and 9 WHEREAS, the law firm of Marks and Marks of Phoenix, Arizona, was 10 employed as attorneys for the Papago Tribe to prosecute 11 the above described claims before the Indian Claims Com-12 13 mission; and WHEREAS, said attorneys have recommended to the Papago Tribe a 14 \$26,000,000 settlement of said claims, proposed in a letter 15 from Royal D. Marks to the Honorable Edward H. Levi, 16 Attorney General of the United States, dated December 22, 17 1975, and accepted by letter dated February 19, 1976, 18 from Peter R. Taft, Assistant Attorney General for Land 19 and Natural Resources Division, which settlement is condi-20 tioned upon formal approval of the Papago Council and the 21 vote of the members of the Papago Tribe; and 22 WHEREAS, the Tribe's said attorneys have requested the Papago Coun-23 cil for approval to proceed further with the proposed set-24 tlement and its submission to the members of the Papago 25 26 Tribe; and WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the Papago Tribe if the proposed 27 settlement is submitted for formal approval and ratifica-28 tion by the members and Council of the Papago Tribe as 29 soon as possible since, if approved soon, it may be possi-30 ble to obtain the required Congressional judgment fund 31 appropriation before Congress recesses for the election 32
