

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 11-76

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona has, by means of an E.D.A.
2 grant, built a Cattle Livestock Complex at Sells, Arizona;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, there is an immediate need for support in financing salary,
5 wages and maintenance of said Cattle Livestock Complex; and

6 WHEREAS, there is also an immediate need for support money for on
7 the job training of the Tribal Cattle Complex assistant
8 manager, staff workers and miscellaneous necessary person-
9 nel; and

10 WHEREAS, an agriculture project, known as the Vaiva Vo irrigation
11 project, is in the process of being developed in the Sif
12 Oidak District, Papago Reservation; and

13 WHEREAS, there is an immediate need for support in financing sala-
14 ries, wages and maintenance of the Vaiva Vo irrigation
15 project; and

16 WHEREAS, there is also an immediate need for support money for on
17 the job training of the Vaiva Vo agriculture project
18 assistant manager, staff workers and miscellaneous person-
19 nel; and

20 WHEREAS, the Tribe has been informed that the Indian Action Commit-
21 tee with head offices in San Francisco, California, has
22 monies available for the above purposes; and

23 WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the Tribe to send
24 Max Norris, Charlie Whitfield and other necessary parties
25 as authorized by the Tribal Chairman to San Francisco,
26 California, to meet with the Indian Action Committee with
27 supporting documents and request for the above mentioned
28 support money.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Max Norris, Vice Chairman of
30 the Papago Tribe; Charlie Whitfield, BIA Agency Land
31 Operational Officer, Papago Reservation; and other neces-
32 sary parties as authorized by the Tribal Chairman, be and

1 they are hereby authorized to meet with the Indian Action
2 Committee as soon as possible to submit the Papago Tribal
3 request for support in financing salaries, wages and main-
4 tenance of the Papago Cattle Livestock Complex and the
5 Vaiva Vo irrigation project, and for support money for on
6 the job training of the training of assistant managers,
7 staff workers and necessary miscellaneous personnel to
8 operate the Papago Cattle Complex and the Vaiva Vo irriga-
9 tion project.

10 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
11 the 5th day of March, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was
12 present with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 4
13 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Sec-
14 tion 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of
15 the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12,
1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6,
1937 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval
by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is not subject to
review by the Secretary of Interior.
