

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(FY 1977 Funding)

RES. NO. 15-76

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona has had a long range planning
2 program for several years; and
3 WHEREAS, based upon said program the Papago Council has approved
4 certain projects and programs in accordance with priorities
5 therein set forth for the Papago Indian Reservation for
6 which special FY 1977 Funding Appropriations are needed; and
7 WHEREAS, said program requires the cooperation and assistance of
8 many Federal agencies and the United States Congress; and
9 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe wishes to coordinate said program in close
10 cooperation with the appropriate Federal agencies,
11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that the
12 Chairman of the Papago Council be and he is hereby autho-
13 rized to take any and all steps necessary to insure that
14 the said program is properly funded and that the necessary
15 coordination with appropriate Federal agencies is received
16 to implement said program.

17 The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
18 the 11th day of March, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was
19 present with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0
20 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by
21 Section 2 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the
22 Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12,
23 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6,
24 1937, (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
25 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval
26 by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to
27 review by the Secretary of the Interior.
