

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 21-76

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe proposes to contract directly for funds payable under  
2 the Johnson O'Malley Act for Indian education programs at schools on the  
3 Papago Reservation; and

4 WHEREAS, the Papago Education Committee, composed of representatives from each of  
5 the eleven Districts of the Papago Reservation, was created and charged  
6 by the Papago Council to assist all schools and educational programs on  
7 the Papago Reservation; and

8 WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Papago Education Committee that the  
9 Indian Education Parents Committees-established at each of the schools  
10 on the Papago Reservation as the local parents' advisory committee man-  
11 dated by the Johnson O'Malley Act-shall be responsible for deciding to  
12 which education program the funds payable under the Act should be allo-  
13 cated; and

14 WHEREAS, the Papago Council concurs with the recommendation of the Papago Educa-  
15 tion Committee.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Papago Tribe adopts  
17 the following plan of operation to administer the funds payable to the  
18 Papago Tribe for education programs of the schools on the Papago Reserva-  
19 tion and received by the Tribe under the provisions of the Johnson  
20 O'Malley Act, to-wit:

- 21 1. The Papago Education Committee shall be responsible for the  
22 general supervision of funds paid to the Papago Tribe as con-  
23 tractor for Indian education programs under the Johnson O'Malley  
24 Act.
- 25 2. The Indian Education Parents Committee of each school shall,  
26 in cooperation with the administration of the school, determine  
27 the educational programs it wishes the school to provide and  
28 fund by means of funds allocated to the school pursuant to the  
29 provisions of the Johnson O'Malley Act, and shall make a report  
30 thereof to the Papago Education Committee.
- 31 3. The Papago Education Committee shall cause to be released to  
32 each school the funds allocated to the school under the provi-

sions of the Johnson O'Malley Act in accordance with the direc-  
tion of such school's Indian Education Parents Committee and  
shall file periodic reports with the Papago Council on the allo-  
cation and use of such funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Papago Council shall develop admin-  
istrative guidelines necessary to implement the purpose of this Resolution

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day of  
May, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 727.5 for;  
33.0 against; 73.5 not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in  
the Council by Section 2 (a), (d), (e), (f) and (k) of Article V of the Constitu-  
tion and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on  
December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6,  
1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said  
Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of  
the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
