

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 23-76

1 WHEREAS, Warren L. Eyer and Susan L. Eyer, husband and wife did by Warranty Deed  
2 convey to the United States of America, in trust and for the benefit of  
3 the Papago Indian Tribe, certain lands located in Pinal County, Arizona,  
4 known as Papago Florence Village and more particularly described as  
5 follows:

6 Beginning at the northeast corner of the Eyer property,  
7 which is designated as Parcel No. 1 within Section 3,  
8 Township 5 South, Range 9 East, Gila and Salt River  
9 Meridian, Arizona. The Metes-and-Bounds description is  
10 as follows:

11 Line AP 1 - AP 2 S. 81° 55' W., 2.443 chs., line AP 2 -  
12 AP 3 S. 20° 35' E., 0.800 chs., line AP 3 - AP 4 S. 66°  
13 31' E., 1.434 chs., Line AP 4 AP 5 S. 0° 55' E., 3.030  
14 chs., line AP 5 - AP 6 S. 89° 05' W., 2.879 chs., line  
15 AP 6 - AP 7 N. 0° 55' W., 4.212 chs., line AP 7 - AP 8  
16 S. 74° 10' W., 3.036 chs. (end of course, intersect the  
17 north and south centre line of the southeast quarter of  
18 Section 3), line AP 8 - AP 9 (on the north and south  
19 centre line of the southeast quarter) S. 0° 39' E.,  
20 32.10 chs. (end of course, the east 1/16 sec. cor. of  
21 secs. 3 and 19), line AP 9 - AP 10 (between sections 3  
22 and 10) N. 88° 55' E., 6.69 chs., line AP 10 - AP 1 N,  
23 0° 42' W., 33.33 chs. (end of course, the place of  
24 beginning); and

25 WHEREAS, said lands were acquired by the United States of America under provisions  
26 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984); and

27 WHEREAS, it is the wish of the Papago Tribe that said lands be added to and made  
28 a part of the Papago Indian Reservation.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Secretary of Interior  
30 is hereby requested for an order or other appropriate action setting aside  
31 said lands as tribal lands for the benefit of the Papago Indians of  
32 Arizona and making said lands a part of the Papago Indian Reservation.

33 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day of  
34 May, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0 for;  
35 0 against; 0 not voting; and 4 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago  
36 Council by Article I and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-  
37 laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936,  
38 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, and pursuant to  
39 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effec-  
40 tive as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency,  
41 and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
