

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 27-76

1 WHEREAS, Ed Emmons, is the Administrative Manager of the Papago Agency and, upon
2 the retirement of Joseph M. Lucero, was appointed temporary Superinten-
3 dent of said Agency; and
4 WHEREAS, Ed Emmons is employed by the Department of Interior in the Grade of GS-12;
5 and
6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes that his position with the Papago Agency
7 warrants a rank equal to or above the rank of GA-13; and
8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has learned that he has received an offer of promotion
9 to GS-13 conditioned upon his working with a different Federal agency; and
10 WHEREAS, the Papago Council appreciates the substantial services he has rendered
11 to the Papago Tribe; recognizes the special knowledge and understanding
12 he has acquired of the Tribe's affairs and needs; and believes it essen-
13 tial to the Tribe's welfare that he remain on the Papago Reservation at
14 least during a reasonable adjustment period necessary for a yet to be
15 designated Superintendent of the Papago Agency to familiarize himself
16 with the Tribe's affairs and needs; and
17 WHEREAS, the Papago Council recognizes that it would be unfair to Ed Emmons and
18 his family to ask him to forego a promotion in order to stay on the Papa-
19 go Reservation for the benefit of the Papago Tribe.
20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it recommends to, and
21 requests the Secretary of Interior forthwith to grant a promotion to Ed
22 Emmons to the rank of GS-13 in order to permit him to remain on the
23 Papago Reservation without undue sacrifice to himself and his family.
24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day of
25 May, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0 for;
26 0 against; 0 not voting; and 4 absent; pursuant to authority
27 vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (f) of Article V of the Constitution
28 and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12,
1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
Agency, and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
