HEREAS, Ed Emmons, is the Administrative Manager of the Papago Agency and, upon 1 the retirement of Joseph M. Lucero, was appointed temporary Superinten-2 dent of said Agency; and 3 WHEREAS, Ed Emmons is employed by the Department of Interior in the Grade of GS-12; 4 and 5 WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes that his position with the Papago Agency 6 warrants a rank equal to or above the rank of GA-13; and 7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has learned that he has received an offer of promotion 8 to GS-13 conditioned upon his working with a different Federal agency; and 9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council appreciates the substantial services he has rendered 10 to the Papago Tribe; recognizes the special knowledge and understanding 11 he has acquired of the Tribe's affairs and needs; and believes it essen-12 tial to the Tribe's welfare that he remain on the Papago Reservation at 13 least during a reasonable adjustment period necessary for a yet to be 14 designated Superintendent of the Papago Agency to familiarize himself 15 with the Tribe's affairs and needs; and 16 WHEREAS, the Papago Council recognizes that it would be unfair to Ed Emmons and 17 his family to ask him to forego a promotion in order to stay on the Papa-18 go Reservation for the benefit of the Papago Tribe. 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it recommends to, and 20 requests the Secretary of Interior forthwith to grant a promotion to Ed 21 Emmons to the rank of GS-13 in order to permit him to remain on the 22 Papago Reservation without undue sacrifice to himself and his family. 23 The foregoing Resolution wad duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day of 24 lay, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of absent; pursuant to authority not voting; and against; 25 vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago 26 27 Agency, and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior. 28 29
