

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 30-76

1 WHEREAS, an essential part of the Economic Development Administration
2 (EDA) grant for expanding the San Xavier Industrial Park for
3 the Empire Machinery Company and other large users is special
4 BIA assistance on street construction; and

5 WHEREAS, EDA considers help from BIA on street construction in the
6 Industrial Park to be a pre-condition before EDA will allow
7 any disbursement of grant funds for Park expansion; and

8 WHEREAS, any undue delay in approving and constructing the BIA inter-
9 rior streets might halt the entire \$411,000 EDA grant for
10 the Industrial Park (including the \$3,000,000 Empire Machin-
11 ery Company plant facility); and

12 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Roads has received
13 authorization from the Superintendent and from BIA Phoenix
14 Area Office to construct these new streets in the Park sub-
15 ject to available BIA road funds and to approval by the
16 Papago Council.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that the Bureau
18 of Indian Affairs Branch of Roads is hereby authorized and
19 empowered to construct approximately 1800 feet of paved
20 streets in the San Xavier Industrial Park (Tract #2) at a
21 cost of approximately \$60,000 using whatever extra BIA funds
22 can be obtained for this special purpose and without affect-
23 ing in any way whatsoever the Papago Tribe's Priority List
24 for FY 77 Road Construction.

25 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
26 the 11th day of June, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was pres-
27 ent with a vote of 536.5 for; 145.0 against; 152.5 not voting; and 3
28 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section
29 (1) Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe
30 of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved
31 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984)
32 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution
is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of
the Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of
the Interior.

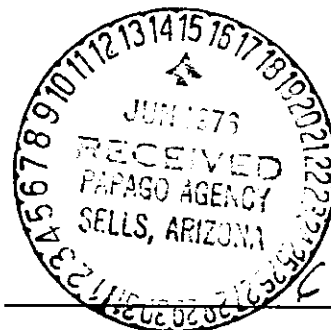
