1 WHEREAS, the amount of Johnson-O'Malley funding per non-BIA Indian
2 student is considerably less than the approximately \$2,000
3 yearly base funding for Indian students attending BIA
4 schools; and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe's Indian Education Committee is very concerned and disappointed that JOM funding base is so low; and WHEREAS, it is essential and in the best interest of the Papago Tribe that funding per non-BIA Indian student be increased to equal the BIA base per Indian student either by increasing

JOM funding per student or by any other supplemental means.

Indian student either by increasing JOM funding per student

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council gives its full support to the Papago Education Committee in regard to this urgent matter and requests the BIA to use every means possible to increase yearly funding per non-BIA Indian student so that such funding equals the BIA yearly base per

or by any other supplemental means.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th day of June, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0 for; O against; O not voting; and I absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2, (a), (d) and (k), Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 States 1984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
