

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAOG COUNCIL

SELF DETERMINATION AND EDUCATION ASSISTANCE AT P.L. 93-638 GRANT FUNDS
FY-76

RES. NO. 41-76

1 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs under authority of P.L. 93-638 (Indian
2 Self Determination Act) has allocated \$101,206 of FY-76 funds for a
3 grant to the Papago Tribe and;

4 WHEREAS, these funds are for use in the development and improvement of Tribal
5 government and;

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has a need and a plan for use of these funds and does
7 meet basic fiscal, personnel and record requirements of this act.

8 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does:

9 A. Stipulate that these funds shall be used in the following areas;

10 1. Purchase of technical assistance needed to update the account-
11 ing and fiscal report system and to study computerization of
12 the system;

13 2. Establishment of a monitoring and coordinating office for
14 Tribal grants and contracts;

15 3. Purchase of additional legal and technical assistance needed
16 to study and improve Tribal Administration and Organization;

17 4. Employment and training of at least two Administrative Tribal
18 Assistants;

19 5. Purchase of technical consultation to study and recommend
20 alternatives for funding of the Indian Oasis School District
21 #40;

22 6. Continuation and Completion of the Tribal Enrollment, if other
23 funds promised are not forthcoming;

24 7. Establishment of a monthly publication to report on Tribal
25 business and affairs;

26 8. Payment of Council expenses for special meetings held to review
27 and study Tribal grants and contracts, or to perform duties
28 related to completion of the Tribal Roll, or to review and
29 decide upon recommendations concerning the Tribal Constitution
30 law.

31 B. Does authorize the Chairman, in consultation with the Treasurer
32 and various departments, to prepare and submit a proposal for use

1 of the \$101,206 within these stipulated areas.
2 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th day
3 August, 1976 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 801 for;
4 0 against; 33 not voting; and 1 absent; pursuant to authority vested in
5 the Papago Council by Section 2(c) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws
6 of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
7 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984)
8 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effect-
9 ive as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency,
10 and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
