

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 43-76

1 WHEREAS, Indian Oasis District #40 has a need for additional building facilities,
2 including two (2) classrooms, counselor offices, and an exercise and
3 storage room; and

4 WHEREAS, the District lacks the bonding capacity to finance these buildings
5 directly; and

6 WHEREAS, at the request of the District the Papago Construction Department has
7 estimated the total cost of these buildings at \$130,000 and does believe
8 that a bank loan can be obtained in the name of the Tribe to finance this
9 construction over a period of five (5) years; and

10 WHEREAS, District #40 Administrative Officials have stated that the District can
11 pay a sum of \$20,000 on completion and can repay the remainder of the
12 loan at a rate of \$25,000 to 30,000 per year over five (5) years; and

13 WHEREAS, this proposal has been reviewed and unanimously approved by both the
14 Papago Tribal Education Committee and the Indian Oasis, District #40,
15 School Board at respective meetings held on July 22, 1976.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that:

- 17 a. It does recognize this need and support this proposal;
18 b. It does authorize the Chairman and his staff to further explore
19 this matter; and

20 Provided, that District Officials can fully satisfy the Tribal Treasurer,
21 Attorney and Business Manager of the District's ability to repay this
22 note within a five (5) year period, it does further authorize the Chair-
23 man to:

- 24 1. Negotiate an outside loan in the name of the Papago Tribe of
25 Arizona in an amount not to exceed \$160,032.60, principle and
26 interest, for the purpose of this construction.
27 2. Negotiate a lease-purchase contract with Indian Oasis District
28 #40 for provision of these buildings, in exchange for such
29 annual payments as shall repay the full cost of construction
30 and financing within a period of not more than five (5) years.

1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th day of
2 August, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 737.5 for;
3 33.0 against; 63.5 not voting; and 1 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the
4 Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of
5 the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
6 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section
7 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of
8 the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not
9 subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
