

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 50-76

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council enacted Resolution No. 12-76 on March 5, 1976
2 expressing the desire of the Papago Tribe to contract with the Bureau of
3 Indian Affairs for tribal court services, reservation police and deten-
4 tion services; and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe recognizes the need to improve the quality of judicial,
6 detention and enforcement services, and feels these reservation services
7 should be under the supervision and control of the Tribe; and

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe does hereby request a contract
9 with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to conduct and provide law enforcement
10 and detention services in accordance with the staffing and funding request
11 enclosed with the Tribe's P. L. 638 contract application. Appropriated
12 federal funds are available at the Papago Agency in Bureau Budget Activity
13 3200 - Law Enforcement.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Tribe does hereby request a contract with the Bureau
15 of Indian Affairs to conduct and provide tribal court services in accord-
16 ance with the Tribe's P. L. 638 contract application. Appropriated
17 federal funds are available at the Papago Agency in Bureau Budget Activity
18 3200 - to be funded jointly by Tribal Court Services and Law Enforcement
19 Services.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe does hereby request a contract with
21 the Bureau of Indian Affairs to conduct, plan and prepare the required
22 reports on reservation law enforcement planning needs, in accordance with
23 the Tribe's P. L. 638 contract application. Appropriated federal funds
24 are available at the Papago Agency in Bureau Budget Activity 3200 - Law
25 Enforcement Services.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Cecil Williams, Chairman of the Papago Tribal
27 Council, or in his absence the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to
28 negotiate and execute the contract or amendments thereto for the duration
29 of the three contracts.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contracting period for judicial services and for
31 police and detention services begins on January 1, 1976 and ends on
32 September 30, 1976, but may be extended by mutual agreement from both

parties.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contracting period for law enforcement planning begins September 15, 1976 and ends September 15, 1977.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day of September, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.

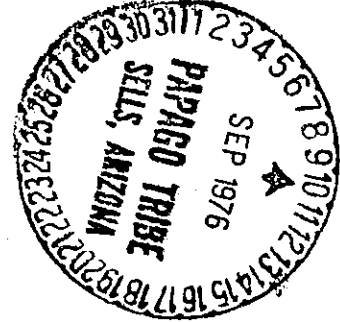
