should be under the supervision and control of the Tribe; and NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe does hereby request a contract

9 with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to conduct and provide law enforcement 10 and detention services in accordance with the staffing and funding request 11 enclosed with the Tribe's P. L. 638 contract application. Appropriated 12 federal funds are available at the Papago Agency in Bureau Budget Activity 13 3200 - Law Enforcement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Tribe does hereby request a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to conduct and provide tribal court services in accordance with the Tribe's P. L. 638 contract application. Appropriated federal funds are available at the Papago Agency in Bureau Budget Activity 3200 - to be funded jointly by Tribal Court Services and Law Enforcement Services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe does hereby request a contract with
 the Bureau of Indian Affairs to conduct, plan and prepare the required
 reports on reservation law enforcement planning needs, in accordance with
 the Tribe's P. L. 638 contract application. Appropriated federal funds
 are available at the Papago Agency in Bureau Budget Activity 3200 - Law
 Enforcement Services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Cecil Williams, Chairman of the Papago Tribal
 Council, or in his absence the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to
 negotiate and execute the contract or amendments thereto for the duration
 of the three contracts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contracting period for judicial services and for
 police and detention services begins on January 1, 1976 and ends on
 September 30, 1976, but may be extended by mutual agreement from both
