

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 51-76

1 WHEREAS, alcoholism and severe drinking are major problems among the Papago people  
2 and do severely disrupt family community life; and

3 WHEREAS, recognizing the need for an alcoholism rehabilitation program, the Papago  
4 Council, by Resolution No. 1-73, did authorize the Chairman of the Alcoholism  
5 Prevention Program and the Executive Health Staff to call upon tribal  
6 resources to support the establishment of an alcoholism rehabilitation  
7 facility; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tribe does operate an Alcoholism Rehabilitation Center, The Tohono  
9 O'othum House Program, which Program is capable of providing institu-  
10 tional rehabilitation services for Indian persons with alcoholic problems;  
11 and

12 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs does have an existing contract with the  
13 Papago Tribe for such services; and

14 WHEREAS, it is in the mutual interest of the Tribe and the Bureau to continue said  
15 contract in FY-77 under P.L. 93-638 laws and regulations; and

16 WHEREAS, Bureau funds are available for such services.

17 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe does request a contract with  
18 the Bureau of Indian Affairs to provide rehabilitation care services for  
19 Indian persons with alcohol problems in accordance with the funding re-  
20 quest enclosed with the Tribe's P.L. 638 contract application.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Cecil Williams, Chairman of the Papago Council, or in  
22 his absence the Vice Chairman, is hereby authorized to negotiate and  
23 execute the contract or amendments thereto for the duration of these con-  
24 tracts.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this contract shall begin on October 1, 1976 and end  
26 on September 30, 1977.

27 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day of  
28 September, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0  
29 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent; pursuant to the  
30 authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution  
31 and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on  
December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution  
is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago  
Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
