Melissa Norris

Harriet Toro

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th day of October, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
