RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 59-76

WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on September 25, 1975, pass Ordinance 1 No. 55, superseding and voiding Ordinances No. 39 (passed 2 on September 2, 1960), and No. 42 (passed on August 4, 1961) 3 and ordaining that all income derived from the use, permit, 4 or lease of Tribal lands for mining purposes, including gas 5 and oil, after September 25, 1975, be allocated as follows: 6 7 One-half thereof shall be deposited to the 1) general account of the Papago Tribe to be appropriated under Tribal budget or by Resolution 8 of the Papago Tribal Council, along with other 9 Tribal income, for the use and benefit of the Papago Tribe; and 10 2) One-half thereof shall be deposited in an 11 interest bearing account for the benefit of the eleven Districts of the Papago Reservation until 12 the Papago Tribal Council shall, by superseding Ordinance, have determined how, when and in which proportions the junds in said account shall 13 be paid to or for the benefit of the various Districts of the Papago Reservation; and 14 WHEREAS, the original copy of aforementioned Ordinance No. 55 was 15 16 lost in transit and before it could be reviewed by the 17 Secretary of Interior; and WHEREAS, it was and is the intention of the Papago Council that said 18 19 Ordinance No. 55 take effect at the date of its enactment. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does 20 21 hereby enact and republish Ordinance No. 55, a copy of which 22 is attached hereto and is by this reference incorporated 23 herein, nunc pro tunc and effective as of the date of its 24 enactment on September 25, 1975. 25 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on October 8, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent; pursuant 26 to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (1) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, 27 ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the 28 29 30 Interior. 31 32
