

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 61-76

1 WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the Papago people and Papago Council
2 to apply for funds to continue the Community Action Program
3 in serving the basic needs of the Papago villages; and

4 WHEREAS, the Washington Office of Native American Programs (ONAP)
5 has allocated a sum of \$357,000.00 for use in these programs
6 for 1976-77, which sum has been the same for the past four
7 (4) years; and


8 WHEREAS, the C.A.P. Board which is composed of one (1) representa-
9 tive from each of the eleven (11) districts is delegated
10 the authority to review and recommend upon the proposal,
11 plans and budgets of these funds; and

12 WHEREAS, on August 19, 1976 the C.A.P. Board did approve the attached
13 resolution.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby
15 recognize and accept the attached resolution dated August
16 19, 1976.


17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
18 the 8th day of October, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was
19 present with a vote of 782.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting;
20 and 3 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council
21 by Section 2 (a) and (d) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Con-
22 stitution of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on
23 December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on
24 January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
25 June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its
26 approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject
27 to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
