RES. NO. 63-76

WHEREAS, by letter dated June 29, 1976, Morris Thompson, Commissioner of Indian Affairs, advised that on July 18, 1977, the statute of limitations codified as 28 U.S.C., Sections 2415 and 2416, will prevent the United States from litigating certain claims on behalf of Indians and Indian Tribes which arose before July 18, 1966, and requested all Area Directors and Agency Superintendents to identify and document such claims before such deadline approaches; and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes that the Papago Tribe has claims for damages under the <u>Winters</u> and <u>Cappaert</u> doctrines of the U. S. Supreme Court involving the loss of water sustained as a result of excessive water withdrawals and the lowering of the ground water tables beneath the Papago Reservation in the Avra Valley Basin, in the Casa Grande-Stanfield area, and in the area of the Gila Bend Reservation, which claims for damages are within the purview of 28 U.S.C., Sections 2415 and 2416.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to take notice of the claims of the Papago Tribe under the Winters and Cappaert doctrines for damages resulting from the loss of water sustained as a result of excessive water withdrawals and the lowering of the ground water tables beneath the Papago Reservation in the Avra Valley Basin, in the Casa Grande-Stanfield area, and in the area of the Gila Bend Reservation, and requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to identify and document such claims, and to prepare and process all litigation investigations, reports and requests necessary in order for the United States on behalf of the Papago Tribe to initiate appropriate litigation prior to July 18, 1977, for the recovery of money damages for such loss of water, for a declaration of the rights of the Papago Tribe in and to the use of surface and groundwaters in said areas, and for injunctive relief to prohibit withdrawals of surface and groundwaters in derogation of or to the detriment of the rights of the Papago Tribe in and to the surface and groundwaters in said areas.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the <u>8th</u> day of October, 1976, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 834.0 for; <u>0</u> against; <u>0</u> not voting; and <u>2</u> absent; pursuant to authority
